

COVID UPDATE: 2/19/2021

After careful consideration and debate, the Covered Bridge BOD has made the following changes to our COVID-19 Protection Plans.

- Outside activities are now open for family members/guest (pickleball, shuffleboard, cornhole, and horseshoes)
- Indoor facilities remain closed to non-residents or family members/guest (billiards, exercise room, and library)
- The pool is restricted to residents only from dawn to 3:00 pm and then will be open to family/guest from 3:00 pm to dusk

Covered Bridge is still closed to non-residents, we are only allowing family members/guest and essential services to be in our community. We ask everyone to ensure those you invite into our community have taken precautions, have not been around anyone with COVID 19 and do not exhibit any symptoms.

This was not an easy decision and not taken lightly by any Board member. It was not a unanimous decision and I understand and respect the opinions of every board member. Their service and work to keep us safe and functioning is greatly appreciated.

First and foremost, we considered everyone's safety and secondly, everyone's rights as an owner of Covered Bridge. The COVID-19 virus is certainly not gone, but society has gotten much better at protecting ourselves.

While we are opening some of our common areas, we still caution people to social distance whenever possible, sanitize often while in public and insist others wear their mask when that is not possible – the mask will minimize the germs you spread to others, they do not protect you from the virus. So, when you get close, wear one to protect those around you!
