BULK WASTE PICKUP

YARD WASTE PICKUP

Bulk waste and yard waste will alternate every other week and must be placed outside the carts, near the curb, for pick up on your scheduled trash collection day.

Yard waste needs to be placed in a separate container, bagged or tied in bundles that are less than 6 feet in length and less than 50 lbs. per bundle, bag or container. Only 2 cubic yards per resident will be picked up on your scheduled day.

Do not put any yard or bulk waste in blue or green carts. Contact Waste Connections to schedule pick-up of tires and white goods (refrigerators, ranges, washers, dryers, water heaters, dishwashers and other similar appliances).
